



Ruddington Walking Bus

Information for parents

We are pleased to inform you that the walking bus will start on Tuesday 3rd September and run in the mornings only from James Peacock School to St Peter's. The plan is for the bus to be available every morning and we will review this on a half termly basis dependant on volunteer numbers.

Bus Details:

Leaving James Peacock School at 8.35am

The adults acting as 'drivers' and 'conductors' will be waiting on the grass in front of the school they will be wearing florescent/reflective tabards which will also be issued to all registered children using the Walking Bus.

The bus route which has been risk assessed will be: Manor Park, Wilford Road, St Johns Rd, St Mary's Park, Ling Crescent, Packman, Ashworth Avenue.

Arrive at St Peter's school at approx. 9am

And will be met on site by a school staff member.
